Apply For Special 4-H Fair Awards

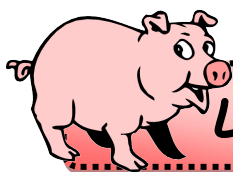

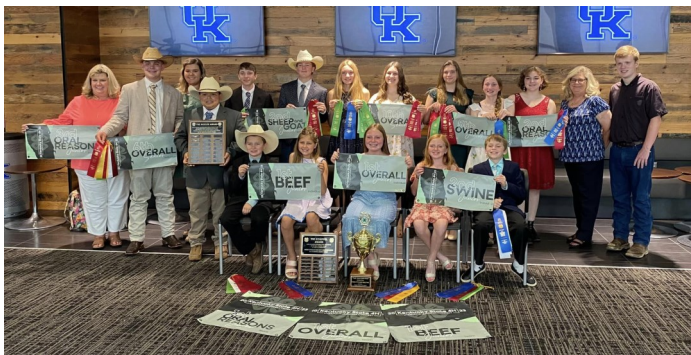
